

Huntoon Stables Student Horse Show

NOV. 23 & 24, 2024

Welcome to Huntoon Stables' 2024 Fall Student Horse Show. There are twenty-seven events with horses (plus a couple of special activities) ranging from classes for beginners thru advanced, and a variety of fun classes.

Our stable shows are put on for the entertainment and education of our riding students.

The show is held on Saturday evening and Sunday afternoon. Saturday evening's show begins at 7:00 P.M. sharp. The Sunday show will begin at 11:00 a.m. Riders should be at the stable a **minimum** of one-half hour before the start of the performance they participate in.

Spectators may watch from the Viewing Room, which is heated, or from the north end of the Riding Hall. The arena doors will be closed due to cold weather, so audience members may walk through the arena between classes. Please stay behind the barricades while the classes are moving and do not lean on or over them. Camcorders and flash photography are allowed.

Remember the stable rules – no running, no loud noises and do not pet the horses on their nose. Be careful walking through the barn aisle. There will be a lot of activity and we have several horses that aren't as accustomed to large amounts of activity as are many of the older horses.

An outside person from another teaching program judges the classes. It has become standard in horse shows to present awards through sixth place. We follow this practice in many classes but have increased the number in some of our classes.

We also present special awards which are based on points, with 1st place worth 100, 2nd worth 98, etc. Our *High Point* awards are based on points earned from placing in any of our events. Our *Eventing Award* is based on points earned in Advanced Pleasure, Pre-Advanced/Intermediate Pleasure, Working Pleasure, Pattern and Obedience. Our *Horsemanship Award* is based on points earned in Horsemanship, Stock Seat and Showmanship. Our *Fun Award* is based on points earned in Advanced Grooming, Extreme Obedience and Extreme Horsemanship. To be eligible for any of the last three awards, a rider must participate in their section of each of the qualifying classes for that award.

In general, riders are judged on their ability to make their horses perform properly, the correctness of their posture, their **energy** and **effort** to control the horse at all times **and** their interest in riding to their highest level of ability.

We encourage our riders not to ride for ribbons, but to do the very best job they can each time they enter the ring and the ribbons will come. The riders must be <u>motivated</u> to do a good job but still realize there will be more classes and shows for them, that no one wins every time and that you must learn from each riding experience.

The Horsemanship classes are divided by age and riding levels. Many of the other classes are not. We encourage the students to exhibit in some of the non-traditional classes to help them learn more and get started in something more challenging.

Novice classes are for riders who ride at a walk and trot only – they do not canter yet. Riders in Intermediate, Pre-advanced

and Advanced ride at a walk, trot and canter.

Many of our classes are *horsemanship* classes. They are judged on the rider's horsemanship skills, proper body position, how well they handle the horse, correct leads and diagonals and whether they are giving the horse proper signals.

Some of the classes are *pleasure* classes. These are judged partially on the horse – its behavior, its apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride, how it carries itself and if it performs its gaits properly. Good horsemanship is necessary to achieve these qualities, and the class is also judged on the rider's ability to acquire the best performance from their horse.

"Diagonals" refer to how the rider posts. When the horse is trotting, its legs move in diagonal pairs (i.e. left front/right hind then right front/left hind). When riding in an arena, the rider should always rise in unison with the outside front leg (the leg closest to the wall). This helps balance the horse when it goes around corners or performs in a circle. Posting on the incorrect diagonal may lower your final placing.

"Leads" refers to how the horse canters. The canter is a three beat gait starting with one hind leg, then the other hind leg in unison with the diagonal front leg and, finally the other front leg. The front leg that hits the ground on the final, or third, beat is the farthest forward, so it leads. When cantering in an arena, it is important that your horse leads with its inside front leg to make it easier and smoother when it canters a turn. Allowing your horse to canter on the incorrect lead may adversely effect your placing in the class.

Showmanship at Halter classes are judged on the handler's ability to properly lead a horse and present it for judging. There is a prescribed pattern that each handler must follow. They lead their horse in a straight line down the center of the arena to the judge where they are to stop and properly position their horse. The handler stands in front of the horse and moves left or right so they are never between the judge and the horse. In the more advanced Showmanship classes, the rider's and horse's grooming are also judged and the pattern may vary. When the judge has finished examining the horse, the handler turns the horse around in a clockwise direction, then trots it back to where they started, stops, turns clockwise and faces the judge, nods acknowledgement to the judge, then returns to the line-up or holding area.

Sometimes, in a stable show, the judge will credit a rider for making the correct moves and attempting to do the correct thing, even if the horse does not respond correctly.

We want to thank all of our students for the time they have put in to practice for the show and to their parents for their efforts to bring them to their lessons.

For many of our students, riding is not just a 'passing fancy'. Riding is a sport that one can continue with well into their later years in life and it provides many health benefits.

Over the years we have been teaching, several of our students have stayed highly involved in the industry, including becoming professionally involved as teachers or trainers.

Please do not block the video camera!

The video camera is located in the front corner of the seating area. Please do not stand directly in front of it. We now stream the entire performance so that those who can't attend may watch from wherever they are located.
